

2nd CAMPILLOS INTERNATIONAL PIANO COMPETITION

The 2nd Campillos International Piano Competition will be held at the IES Concert Hall, in Campillos, (Málaga), Spain, December 5th-8th, 2008.

I - CONDITIONS

- 1** - The Competition is open to pianists of any nationality, born after January 1st, 1978. The winner of the past edition is not allowed to compete again.
- 2** - Application materials must be received no later than November 1st, 2008, and must be sent to:

- 3** - The contestants' performances will be in alphabetical order, determined by a draw, which will be valid for all rounds. The draw will take place during the Reception at the "Casa de la Cultura" in Campillos on December 5th 2008, at 12,00 hrs. All contestants must be present. The resulting order can only be modified under exceptional circumstances, in which case the contestant must provide a justification and the Organization will make a final decision after considering the reasons.
- 4** - The contestants may try the piano at the Concert Hall on December 5th 2008 after the draw.
- 5** - The Competition will have pianos for practising at the contestants' disposal.
- 6** - The Competition reserves the right to authorize the recording and broadcasting of any of the Competition rounds.
- 7** - The Competition organization will provide information about accommodation in Campillos during the Competition.

II - APPLICATIONS

- 1** - The following documents must be sent well before November 1st, 2008, in order to arrive not later than November 1st:
 - a) Photocopy of legal document regarding age and nationality.
 - b) One passport size photograph, in a digital format, if possible, sent by e-mail.
 - c) A brief Curriculum Vitae in spanish or english.
 - d) Application form with contestant data and complete programme: title, composer and timing, for the different rounds.
- 2** - In the case of many applications, the Organization will limit participation in the Competition to those pianists who are among the first 50 to apply and will notify each participant by November 5th if his application has been selected. Selected contestants should pay a 50 Euro entry fee, free of any charge for the receiver, before November 8th by bank transfer to:

Participation is not definitive until the entry fee is received. This fee cannot be refunded under any circumstances.

Applications may be sent by E-mail.

III - COMPETITION STAGES

- 1** - The Competition consists of an Eliminary Round and Final, both of them open to the public.
ELIMINATORY ROUND: A programme lasting no longer than 20 minutes, composed of:
 - One Prelude and Fugue from "The Well-Tempered Clavier" by J.S.Bach, or one Sonata by D. Scarlatti or Padre Soler.

- One virtuoso Study.
- One or several pieces of free choice.

The number of candidates admitted to the Final Round will depend on the level reached in the Eliminary Round.

FINAL: A self chosen programme lasting no longer than 40 minutes, consisting of pieces of different styles.

Pianist wishing to compete for the Spanish Music Prize, must play at least one piece by a Spanish composer.

2 - No work may be repeated.

3 - All the works must be performed by heart.

IV - PRIZES

FIRST PRIZE: Diploma and cash award of 4000 Euro.

SECOND PRIZE: Diploma and cash award of 2000 Euro.

THIRD PRIZE: Diploma and cash award of 1000 Euro.

SPECIAL PRIZE for the best performance of Spanish Music: Diploma and cash award of 1000 Euro.

SPECIAL PRIZE for the best Spanish pianist: Diploma and cash award of 1000 Euro.

The First Prize is indivisible, but the other prizes may be shared.

The Competition organization in cooperation with other entities will offer the possibility to organize some concerts for the winner of the Competition.

Finalists not receiving any prize will get a Finalist Diploma and 250 Euro as a financial aid.

The jury is not obliged to award all the prizes. Their decision is final.

All grants and prizes shall be subject to taxes at the statutory rate.

The awarded pianists must personally collect their prize in the Closing Act, and will play during the Winners Concert without receiving a remuneration. A refusal entails cancellation of the award.

November 5th:

Notification of acceptance.

December 5th:

12,00 hrs. Reception for contestants and Draw at "La Casa de la Cultura" in Campillos.

Afterwards, piano try-out by contestants at Concert Hall.

19,30 hrs. **Inauguration Act.**

- Presentation.
- Opening Concert.
- Cocktail for contestants, jury, sponsors and invited guests.

December 6th-7th: ELIMINATORY ROUND.

December 8th: FINAL.

December 8th:

20,00 hrs. **Closing Act.**

- Prize-giving Ceremony.
- Winners Concert.
- Cocktail for contestants, jury, sponsors and invited guests.

Organizing Committee shall solve all those situations not specified in these regulations.

In case of any difference between the Spanish and English versions of these rules, the Official Spanish text will prevail.

By sending the application form, the applicant agrees to accept and to comply with all regulations of the contest.

VI - LOCATION

Campillos, in the province of Malaga, is well-connected with the main Andalusian cities like Malaga, Seville or Granada. These cities have International Airports. From Malaga and Seville Bus Stations there are connections to Campillos. There are also many possibilities for travelling from these three cities by train to any of the two Railway Stations located 13 Kms from Campillos, called "Bobadilla" and "Antequera-Santa Ana". From both places you can take a train to Campillos Railway Station or you can also take a taxi to Campillos, which takes about 10 minutes.
